REGULATIONS

Made by the President under section 7 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (AMENDMENT) (NO. 6) REGULATIONS, 2025

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers Citation (Amendment) (No. 6) Regulations, 2025.
- 2. In these Regulations, "the Regulations" means the Emergency Interpretation Powers Regulations, 2025. $\frac{\text{L.N. No. 241}}{\text{of } 2025}$
- 3. The Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 20, Regulation 20A the following regulation:

"Liability under other written laws 20A. For the avoidance of doubt, where a police officer, in lawful exercise of his powers under these Regulations, finds evidence that a person has committed or is committing an offence under any other written law, that person is liable to be prosecuted and punished for that offence in accordance with that written law.".

4. These Regulations are deemed to have come into force on Commencement 18th July, 2025.
