OFFER OF SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE IN CIVIL ENGINEERING AT THE
UNIVERSITY OF THE WEST INDIES, ST. AUGUSTINE

APPLICATIONS are invited from suitably qualified nationals of Trinidad and Tobago for the award of eight (8) scholarships being offered by the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago for studies leading to the bachelor of science degree in Civil Engineering at the University of the West Indies, St. Augustine, commencing from the 2000/2001 academic year.

2. On the completion of the course, the successful candidates will be required to work in the position of Civil Engineer in the Ministry of Works and Transport.

Eligibility

3. All applicants must:

- (a) be citizens of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago;
- (b) possess the General Certificate of Education (GCE) or recognized equivalent (e.g., Caribbean Examination Council (CXC) General Proficiency Grades I or II) with passes in at least five (5) subjects at Ordinary Level, which must include Mathematics, Chemistry and English Language and two (2) "A" Level passes in Mathematics and Physics.

4. The award of a scholarship would be conditional upon the candidate being admitted to the programme of study by the University of the West Indies (UWI), St. Augustine.

Preparation and Submission of Applications

5. Interested persons are advised that application forms and detailed information concerning the terms of the awards and the prescribed conditions for the submission of applications should be obtained from the following offices:

- (a) Scholarships and Advanced Training Division, Ministry of Finance, Planning and Development, ABMA Building, 55-57, St. Vincent Street, Port-of-Spain, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday;
- (b) Administration Building, Jerningham Street, Scarborough, Tobago; and
- (c) Offices of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago Government Diplomat Missions.

6. Completed applications must reach the Scholarships and Advanced Training Division, at the above address, no later than October 12, 2000.

7. Applicants who are Public Officers must submit their applications through their Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Department/Statutory Authorities, as appropriate.

8. Applications not submitted by the closing date or in accordance with the prescribed conditions will not be considered.
