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TENDERS FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF A LAN COMPUTER SYSTEM TO THE SECONDARY EDUCATION MODERNIZATION PROGRAMME CO-ORDINATING UNIT (SEMPCU) MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO has received a loan from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB Loan No. 1180/OC-TT) for which the SEMPCU was established to implement the Programme. The Unit requires a Local Area Network (LAN) to assist in the achievement of the objectives of the Programme.
