PROPOSALS FOR THE OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT OF GOVERNMENT'S GRAVEL PLANT, TAPANA QUARRY,
VALENCIA FOR THE MINISTRY OF INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT

PROPOSALS are invited for a joint venture management arrangement with the Ministry of Infrastructure Development and Local Government to manage and operate Government's Gravel Plant at Tapanas Quarry, Valencia on ninety (90) acres [split into two (2) parts, one approximately 76 acres and the other 14 acres].

Tender documents may be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain. Telephone Numbers 625-4330; 3565; 1809 (Fax).

Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to the Director of Contracts and attach the official receipt to their tender.

A pre-tender meeting will be held at the office of the Ministry of Infrastructure Development and Local Government on the 6th Floor, Richmond Street, Port-of-Spain on Monday 3rd September, 2001 at 10.30 a.m.

Prospective proposers are required to visit the site and acquaint themselves with conditions that may influence or affect their proposals. In this respect, a site inspection will be arranged at the pre-tender meeting.

Tenders will be evaluated and selected on the basis of a two (2) envelopes system. One envelope will contain the Technical Proposal and the other will contain the Price Proposal.

Tenderers are to submit six (6) copies of each [original and five (5) copies] of the Technical and Price Proposals properly labelled. Sealed offers completed and signed will be received up to 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 13th September, 2001. The envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain and deposited in the Brown Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office. All envelopes must be marked on the outside: "Proposal for the Operation and Management of Government Gravel Plant, Tapanas Quarry, Valencia".

The technical proposal will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

As time is of the essence an extension of the closing date will not be granted.

Late tenders will not be considered in any circumstances.
