Save and except the mines and minerals ("the excepted minerals") set out in Deed registered as No. 1106 of 1878 ("the said deed") lying in upon or under the surface of the same *Subject* to the rights and liberties in the said Deed for mining and working the excepted minerals and *Subject also* to the following encumbrances:

3. Judgment in favour of the plaintiff herein against the Defendant herein in High Court Action No. 5099 of 1989 in the sum of \$265,067.54 which said judgment was re-registered on the 28th day of May, 1998 as No. 1129 of 1998.

NOTICE

ENCASHMENT OF GOVERNMENT CHEQUES

Members of the Public are hereby reminded that cheques issued by Government Ministries and Departments are crossed and marked "**Account Payee Only**".

This means that these cheques can only be deposited into Commercial Bank Accounts or encashed at Government paying offices established for this purpose i.e. the Cashier's Unit of the Treasury Division and the District Revenue Offices.

It has been brought to our attention that some of these cheques are being encashed by third parties. Where third parties undertake such encashment these cheques will not be honoured by the Central Bank.

Members of the Public (and in particular the business community) are therefore reminded that they should desist from negotiating these cheques on behalf of the payees as this will result in their accounts not being credited on presentation of the encashed cheques to their bankers.

Due care and attention should therefore be paid to this notice in order to avoid any loss of income.

This notice does not apply to encashment of Old Age Pension Cheques. The Old Age Pension Regulations were amended in 1997 to provide for encashment of these cheques at any supermarket, grocery or shop where certain specified conditions apply. These conditions are as follows and must be strictly complied with in order for the accounts of these businesses to be credited:-

- (1) Payment must only be made to the pensioner himself.
- (2) The payee must endorse the cheque and present proper identification which must be recorded on the back of the cheque.
- (3) The cheque must be endorsed in favour of the owner of the supermarket, grocery or shop in the presence of the owner or his employee.
- (4) Proper identification of the Supermarket/grocery must be stamped on the back of the cheque.
