TENDERS are invited for the repairs of Nine (9) Landslips under the Reinstatement and Stabilization of Failed Slopes Project. Three (3) are on the North Coast Road (Contract No. 12), two (2) on the Moruga Road (Contract No. 13) and four (4) on the Morne St. Catherine Road (Contract No. 15).

5. Tenderers are required to visit the sites and acquaint themselves with site conditions, which may influence or affect their offer. Site inspections will be arranged at the pre-tender meeting by the Project Director, Project Implementation Unit.

6. Separate bids must be submitted for each contract. Prospective contractors may tender for all three (3) contracts but they may be awarded only one contract.
