INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES - MARCH, 2001

General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of March, 2001 was 140.0 showing a decrease of 0.4% under the Index for February, 2001.

The All Items Index for January-March, 2001 showed an increase of 5.6% over that for January-March, 2000. This compares with an increase of 2.9% observed in the Index for January-March, 2000 over that for January-March, 1999.

Section Indices

Food: The Index for this section decreased by 1.1% from 237.6 in February, 2001 to 235.0 in March, 2001. Within the Food Section there was a decrease of 3.2% in the index for market items. Contributing significantly to this decrease were falling prices of irish potatoes, cabbage, tomatoes, and carrots. These decreases in prices were partly offset by an increase in the prices of citrus fruits, sweet potatoes and chicken.

Price changes in this section accounted for a decrease of 0.6 point in the All Items Index.

Other Sections

A further review of the data for March, 2001 compared with February, 2001 indicated that a decrease of 0.2 % was recorded for Clothing and Footwear. Increases of 0.3% and 0.6% were recorded for Drink and Tobacco, and Household Operations respectively.

Price changes in these sections accounted for an increase of 0.1 point in the All Items Index.

Growth in consumer prices in March, 2001 compared with those of March, 2000 reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:-
