INTERNATIONAL PREQUALIFICATION NOTICE FOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTORS FOR YEARS 2 AND 3 CIVIL WORKS IN THE NATIONAL HIGHWAYS PROGRAMME—LOAN NO. 932/OC-TT

*This Notice supercedes all previous published notices for prequalification. All contractors interested in being considered for prequalification for Years 2 and 3 Civil Works, should submit the necessary information in accordance with this Notice. This also applies to all contractors who have submitted prequalification information in response to previously published notices.*

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO has received a loan from the Inter-American Development Bank for the partial financing of the National Highways Programme. The Ministry of Works and Transport is the Executing Agency for the Programme.

2. The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago invites prequalification applications from contracting firms for construction services for Years 2 and 3 Civil Works. Consideration will be limited to contracting firms of joint ventures (not exceeding two (2) firms from the member countries of the Inter-American Development Bank. Eligibility with respect to nationality will be determined in accordance with the rules applicable to the utilization of Inter-American Development Bank financing.

3. The contractors shall be responsible to the Ministry of Works and Transport and shall undertake the work in accordance with the contract documents to be provided subsequently to prequalified firms.

4. The Programme will be executed over six (6) years and part of the works consists of the Rehabilitation of approximately five hundred and eighty-six (586) kilometres of main roads, the reconstruction of sixty-five (65) Bridges and the improvement of approximately fifty (50) kilometres of Trunk Roads.

5. The scope of works for the contractors under this prequalification notice covers construction services to be provided for Years 2 and 3 which consists of the rehabilitation of approximately 100 kms. of primary and secondary roads and the reconstruction of forty (40) Bridges throughout Trinidad and Tobago. Contracting firms which prequalify for Years 2 and 3 works shall be required to repeat the prequalification for each of the subsequent years.

6. Clarification and further information can be obtained from the Project Director as at paragraph 13(1) below. Prequalification questionnaires may be obtained from the Project Director and Director of Highways as at paragraphs 13(1) and (2) below.

7. Any individual contracting firm wishing to prequalify must complete the necessary questionnaire. In the case of joint ventures each firm involved in the partnership must submit a separate questionnaire.

8. Contracting firms or joint ventures applying for prequalification must be competent in the English Language. Applications will be evaluated in accordance with the following criteria:

- (a) general background and organization of firm(s);
- (b) financial capability;
- (c) similar works experience;
- (d) prior experience in a country with similar conditions; and
- (e) available manpower/equipment resources.

9. It is expected that construction work will be commissioned during the fourth quarter of 2001. Firms will be advised of the results of the prequalification notice within four (4) months of the closing date of this notice.

10. The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present prequalification notice in its entirety or even partially without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting its application.

11. The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to categorize contractors in accordance with the amount of works which the Board believes the contractor can reasonably undertake. In categorizing the contractors the Central Tenders Board will analyze all the information supplied.
