## INVITATION FOR PREQUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR THE BRIDGES AND ROADS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN GRENADA

THE GOVERNMENT OF GRENADA (GOG) has applied for a loan from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) towards the cost of the Bridges and Roads Improvement Project (BRIMP) and intends to apply a portion of this loan to eligible payments under the contract for which this Invitation for Prequalification is issued.

The project is being implemented by the Ministry of Works, Communication and Public Utilities (MWCPU) through a Project Co-ordinator who will be responsible for the day-to-day management of project activities. Engineering Consultants have been retained by MWCPU to complete designs and to assist in the tender administration and supervision of contracts.

GOG intends to prequalify contractors for one or more of the following contracts:

- (a) replacement of twelve bridges located throughout Grenada;
- (b) restoration of 10.5 kilometres (km) of roads from Mount Gay to Springs and Morne Jaloux in and around the capital St. George's and replacement of the Temple Bridge; and
- (c) restoration of 9.5 km of roads from Red Gate to Bellevue via Perdmonternps, just east of St. George's and replacement of the Bacolet Bridge.

It is expected that Invitations to Bid will be made in February, 2002.

Consideration will be limited to firms or joint ventures of firms which are legally incorporated or otherwise organised in, and have their principal place of business in one of the member countries of CDB or the Kingdom of the Netherlands and are either—

- (a) more than 50% beneficially-owned by a citizen or citizens and/or a *bona fide* resident or residents of one of the CDB member countries, or by a body corporate or bodies corporate meeting these requirements; or
- (b) owned or controlled by the government of an eligible country provided that it is legally and financially autonomous and operated under the commercial law of an eligible country.

The requirements for prequalification for Contract 1 will include—

- (a) an average annual turnover (defined as billing for works in progress and completed) over the last five years of United States Dollars (USD) 2 million (mn) equivalent;
- (b) experience as prime contractor in the construction of at least two (2) assignments of a nature and complexity comparable to the proposed project activity within the last five years (to comply with this requirement, works quoted should be at least 80 per cent complete); and
- (c) Project (Contract) Manager with fifteen years experience, ten of which have been spent in works of an equivalent nature and scope, including not less than five years as a Manager.

The requirements for prequalification for Contract 2 will include—

- (a) an average annual turnover (defined as billing for works in progress and completed) over the last five years of USD 4 mn equivalent;
- (b) experience as prime contractor in the construction of at least two (2) assignments of a nature and complexity comparable to the proposed project activity within the last five years (to comply with this requirement, works quoted should be at least 80 per cent complete); and
- (c) Project (Contract) Manager with fifteen years experience, ten of which have been spent in works of an equivalent nature and scope, including not less than five years as a Manager.

The requirements for prequalification for Contract 3 will include—

- (a) an average annual turnover (defined as billing for works in progress and completed) over the last five years of USD 5 mn equivalent;
- (b) experience as prime contractor in the construction of at least two (2) assignments of a nature and complexity comparable to the proposed project activity within the last five years (to comply with this requirement, works quoted should be at least 80 per cent complete); and
- (c) Project (Contract) Manager with fifteen years experience, ten of which have been spent in works of an equivalent nature and scope, including not less than five years as a Manager.

The prequalification requirements for firms and/or joint ventures wishing to prequalify for more than one contract are cumulative.

Eligible applicants may obtain prequalification information by calling, writing or faxing to the first address below. The request must clearly state "Request for Prequalification Documents for Bridges and Roads Improvement Project—Grenada". Potential applicants who request that documents be forwarded to them are required to submit an account number from a local courier agent, which accepts freight collect charges. The Project Co-ordinator will promptly dispatch the documents but under no circumstances will be responsible for late delivery or loss of the documents so mailed.
