# Act No. 3 of 2023

An Act to supplement and vary the appropriation of the sum the issue of which was authorised by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2023) Act, 2022

[Assented to 22nd May, 2023]

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{ENACTED}}$  by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{Enactment}}$  follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Short title (Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation) (Financial Year 2023) Act, 2023.

Further issue of \$3,852,055,829 from the Consolidated Fund

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of three thousand, eight hundred and fifty two million, fifty five thousand, eight hundred and twenty nine dollars (\$3,852,055,829) is authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2023 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Act.

Increase in Heads of Expenditure Act No. 20 of 2022

3. The sums appropriated by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2023) Act, 2022 to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Schedule

Reduction in Head of Expenditure

4. The sum appropriated by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2023) Act, 2022 to the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule is reduced by the amount specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Schedule

Sums appropriated in respect of Head the Schedule may be utilised

5. The sum appropriated by the Appropriation specified in Part II of (Financial Year 2023) Act, 2022 in respect of the Head of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule and not utilised at the commencement of this Act may be utilised, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule.
