ORDER

MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ACT

THE COMMON EXTERNAL TARIFF (INCREASE OF DUTY)  
ORDER, 2023

1. This Order may be cited as the Common External Tariff <sup>Citation</sup>  
(Increase of Duty) Order, 2023.

2. In this Order, where “Ex” is used in relation to an item number <sup>Interpretation</sup>  
under a heading listed in the First Column of the First Schedule to the  
Customs Act, that item number shall refer only to the corresponding <sup>Chap. 78:01</sup>  
good described in the Second Column.

3. The Customs Act is amended in the First Schedule in relation to <sup>Increase of</sup>  
the good carrying the headings and descriptions listed below in the <sup>duty in the</sup>  
First and Second Columns respectively, by increasing the rate of duty <sup>First Schedule</sup>  
thereon to the amount stated in the Third Column—

<b>FIRST COLUMN</b> <i>Heading</i>	<b>SECOND COLUMN</b> <i>Description of Goods</i>	<b>THIRD COLUMN</b> <i>Rate of Duty</i>
<b>28.01</b>	<b>Fluorine, chlorine, bromine and iodine.</b>	
Ex 2801.10.00	Chlorine Gas	10%

4. This Order comes into effect on 31st July, 2023.
