REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE CONSENT OF THE
MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)
(PRINCES TOWN) REGULATIONS, 2023

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation
(Experimental Scheme) (Princes Town) Regulations, 2023.

2. These Regulations come into operation on Monday 26th June, 2023 Commencement
and expire on Tuesday 26th September, 2023. and duration

3. (1) A person driving a vehicle, shall not park on— Parking
Prohibited
- (a) the southern side of Aldana Street; and
- (b) St. James Street,

between the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday except on
a public holiday.

(2) Subregulation (1) does not apply to a person driving a Public
Transportation Service Corporation bus.

4. A person driving a vehicle shall not enter— No entry
- (a) St. James Street from St. Croix Road; and
- (b) Aldana Street at its intersection with Charlotte Street,

between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and from 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.
Monday to Friday except on a public holiday.

5. A person who contravenes these Regulations commits a traffic Traffic violation
violation and is liable to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars for the and penalty
first traffic violation and to a fine of one thousand dollars for every
subsequent traffic violation.

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by a commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
