ORDER

Made by the Minister of Works and Transport under section 65 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (SIPARIA) ORDER, 2023

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Siparia) Order, Citation 2023.

2. In this Order the term "S.S. Erin Road" means the San Fernando-Interpretation Siparia-Erin Road.

3. This Order comes into operation on Monday 24th July, 2023. Commencement

4. (1) A person driving a vehicle shall not park on—

```
Parking
prohibited
```

- (a) Lalla Street, Siparia;
- (b) De Gannes Lane, Siparia; and
- (c) Grell Street, Siparia between S.S. Erin Road and Gambal Street, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

(2) A person driving a vehicle shall not park—

- (a) on the western side of the S.S. Erin Road, between the 19.97 Mile Mark and the 20.00 Mile Mark; and
- (b) along the entry and exit ramps in front the Siparia Market compound.

5. A person driving a vehicle shall not turn right from— No right turn

- (a) Lalla Street, onto the S.S. Erin Road; and
- (b) Daisy Voisin Street onto S.S. Erin Road, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.

6. A person who contravenes this Order commits a traffic violation Traffic violation and is liable to a fine of three thousand dollars.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked Chap. 48:507. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
