ORDER

Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (PAN ON D' AVENUE) ORDER, 2023

1. This Order may be cited as as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Pan on D' Avenue) Order, 2023.

2. This Order shall have effect between the hours of 4.00 p.m. on Duration Saturday 26th August, 2023 and 3.00 a.m. on Sunday 27th August, 2023.

3. The driver of a motor vehicle is prohibited from parking on the Parking prohibited following roads:

- (a) between Ariapita Avenue and Wrightson Road along-
 - (i) Ana Street;
 - (ii) French Street; and
 - (iii) Carlos Street;
- (b) Colville Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Tragarete Road;
- (c) Taylor Street, between Warren Street and Ariapita Avenue, save and except where that driver is conveying steelbands;
- (d) Warren Street, between Bellsmythe Street and Rosalino Street;
- (e) Hamilton Holder Street;
- (f) O'Connor Street; and
- (g) Bellsmythe Street.

4. The driver of a motor vehicle is prohibited from driving and Road closed parking along Ariapita Avenue, between O'Connor Street and Colville and vehicular traffic street, save and except where that driver is conveying steelbands.

5. Bands shall assemble on Taylor Street and then proceed east Band route along Ariapita Avenue until Colville Street and on completion of their performance will disassemble at the intersection of Colville Street and Ariapita Avenue. Two-way traffic 6. A driver of a vehicle shall proceed in both directions along the following streets bounded in the north by Warren and Roberts Streets and in the south by Wrightson Road:

- (a) De Verteuil Street;
- (b) Petra Street;
- (c) Gallus Street;
- (d) Alberto Street;
- (e) Rosalino Street;
- (f) Luis Street;
- (g) Alfredo Street;
- (h) Carlos Street;
- (i) Murray Street;
- (j) Fitt Street;
- (k) Cornelio Street; and
- (l) Gatacre Street.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked Chap. 48:50

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
