ORDER

Made by the Commissioner of Police under Section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE) (TOBAGO) ORDER, 2023

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary _{Citation} Provisions) (Independence Day Parade) (Tobago) Order, 2023.

2. This Order shall have effect from 7.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m. on _{Duration} Thursday 31st August, 2023.

3. A driver of a vehicle is prohibited from parking on the following Vehicular roads:

- (a) Claude Noel Highway intersection and the intersection at the Bacolet traffic lights;
- (b) Claude Noel Highway and Friendsfield Road junction to Calder Hall Phase 1;
- (c) Bagatelle Number 2 and Claude Noel Highway;
- (d) Calder Hall intersection;
- (e) Rockley Vale intersection;
- (f) Darrel Spring Road and Wilson Road onto the Claude Noel Highway; and
- (g) Carrington Street and Wilson Road intersection.

4. The driver of a motor vehicle shall proceed in both directions Two-way along Carrington Street between Garden Side Street and Wilson Road. traffic

5. The driver of a motor vehicle is prohibited from parking on the Parking following streets:

- (a) Wilson Road between Claude Noel Highway and Milford Road;
- (b) Bacolet Street;

- (c) Post Office Street;
- (d) Garden Side Street between Darrel Spring Road and Carrington Street; and
- (e) Carrington Street.

Closed car parks 6. The following Public Car Parks shall be closed from 6.00 p.m. on Wednesday 30th August, 2023 to 11.00 a.m. on Thursday 31st August, 2023:

- (a) Garden Side Street; and
- (b) Market Square.

Parking 7. The driver of a motor vehicle is permitted to park in the following areas:

- (a) Car Park East of the Dwight Yorke Stadium (for members of the general public);
- (b) Republic Bank Car Park;
- (c) Old Market Car Park, Piggott Street; and
- (d) NIB Mall (formerly FCB Car Park).

Route to and 8. The driver of a motor vehicle entering and exiting from Scarborough Scarborough—

- (a) travelling from east to west, shall turn onto Windward Road Bacolet and continue along that road into Scarborough;
- (b) proceeding from west to east, shall turn south onto Orange Hill Road to proceed into Scarborough or south onto Mt. Marie Road;
- (c) travelling west to east intending to turn north onto Wilson/ Plymouth Road shall do so and continue north;
- (d) travelling from the North Side Road, shall proceed straight across the highway and into Scarborough;
- (e) travelling along Calder Hall Road, shall travel straight proceeding north and south respectively;
- (f) exiting Scarborough to proceed to the eastern side of Tobago, shall proceed east along Carrington Street onto Burnette Street, east along Main Street and South along Bacolet Street to the Claude Noel Highway and turn east along the Claude Noel Highway; and

(g) exiting Scarborough to proceed to the western side of Tobago, shall proceed west along Carrington Street, continue west along Milford Road, north along Orange Hill Road to the Crusoe Bypass or Claude Noel Highway and continue west.

9. The driver of an emergency vehicle at the dismissal point shall Emergency proceed south along Bay Street onto Carrington Street and continue ^{route} along Milford Road, then turn onto Orange Hill Road to the Claude Noel Highway and continue to the Scarborough Regional Hospital.

10. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention $_{of vehicles}^{impounding}$ of this Order may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt $_{unlawfully}^{vehicles}$ with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and $_{Chap. 48:50}^{parked}$ Road Traffic Act.
