MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE MINIMUM WAGES ACT AND SUBJECT TO NEGATIVE RESOLUTION OF PARLIAMENT

THE MINIMUM WAGES (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2023

1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Amendment) Order, 2023. Citation

2. This Order comes into effect on the 1st day of January, 2024.

Commencement

3. The Minimum Wages Order, 2014 is amended—

L.N. No. 402

(a) in clause 2, by deleting the words "seventeen dollars and fifty cents" wherever they occur and substituting the words "twenty dollars and fifty cents"; and

(b) by deleting the First Schedule and substituting the following Schedule:
