MADE BY THE MINISTER AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE CHIEF JUSTICE
UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 2) ORDER, 2023

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 2) Order, 2023.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

Mr. Tom John Dalton Poole, K.C.	Of the Honourable Society of Inner Temple: Barrister, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in October, 2001 and appointed King's Counsel in 2021.

PART II

Mr. Tom John Dalton Poole, K.C., is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an Attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause and any matters, suits or other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the cause, namely:

Court of Appeal S-161 of 2021/C.V. 2017-03999—(1) The Prime Minister and Head of Cabinet of the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago (2) The Minister of Health and (3) The North Central Regional Health Authority *v* (1) Comprehensive Nephrology Services Limited (2) Biomedical Technologies Limited and (3) Caribbean Kidney Disease Society.
