AN ACT to amend the Administration of Justice
(Indictable Proceedings) Act, 2011 (Act No. 20 of 2011)

[Assented to 4th June, 2024]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Administration of Short title
Justice (Indictable Proceedings) (Amendment) Act, 2024.

2. In this Act, "the Act" means the Administration of Interpretation
Justice (Indictable Proceedings) Act, 2011.

Section 21 amended

3. Section 21 of the Act is amended—

- (a) in subsection (2), in paragraph (a), by inserting after the words “police officer or” the word “given”; and
- (b) by inserting after subsection (8), the following subsection:

“(9) For the purposes of this section, “police officer” means an officer of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service and includes an officer of the Customs and Excise Division, an officer of the Board of Inland Revenue or any officer of an agency of the State, lawfully vested with investigative powers similar to those exercisable by a police officer appointed under the Police Service Act.”.
