CONSUMER PRICE INDEX—August, 2024 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Consumer Price Index (formerly referred to as The Index of Retail Prices) is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The Rate of Inflation, which measures the percentage change in the All Items Index for the month of August 2024 over August 2023, was 0.4%. This rate is less than that observed for the period August 2023 over the period August 2022, which was 4.0%.

The All Items Index calculated from the prices collected for the month of August 2024 was 123.9, which remained unchanged from the All Items Index for July 2024.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased from 149.6 in July 2024 to 149.2 in August 2024, reflecting a decrease of 0.3%. Contributing significantly to this decrease was the general downward movement in the prices of tomatoes, celery, pumpkin, bodi, green sweet peppers, fresh carite, eddoes, soya bean oil, mixed fresh seasoning and pimento. However, the full impact of these price decreases were offset by the general increase in the prices of parboiled rice, fresh whole chicken, irish potatoes, onions, sweet potatoes, eggs, white flour, dasheen, carrots and oranges.

Price changes in this section for the month of August 2024 accounted for a net overall decrease of 0.1 points.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for August 2024 compared with July 2024 reflected increases in the sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of 0.5~% and Health of 0.2%. All other sections remained unchanged.
