APPOINTMENT OF A CUSTOMS AREA
(Customs Act, Chap. 78:01)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Yasmin Harris, Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of Sections 2 and 263(3) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the schedule hereunder, to be a Customs Area in the use of the Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries on behalf of the Government of Trinidad and Tobago, for the storage of petroleum products, which may be deposited, pending entry for home consumption or export.

SCHEDULE

The enclosed site is situated in the western part of the Pointe-a-Pierre Refinery complex adjacent to the La Carriere Electrical Substation, on Paria Fuel Trading Company Limited compound at the Southern Main Road, Pointe-a-Pierre, San Fernando. The roughly rectangular 2.1 hectares site measures 228 meters long (NS) and 91 meters wide. The compound is bounded on the north by the Pointe-a-Pierre Main Road and on its western, eastern and southern sides by lands belonging to the Paria Fuel Trading Company Limited. The entrance to the compound is accessed *via* a gateway along the north-eastern perimeter fence. Immediately left of the entrance is the Diesel Tank D104 which has a storage capacity of 50,000 barrels. The Jet A-I Tank D-103 is located immediately south of tank D-104 and has a storage capacity of 33,000 barrels. Immediately south-west of tank D-103 is the RON 92 Gasoline Tank D-101 with a storage capacity of 33,000 barrels. Obliquely opposite tank D-101 in the south-western direction, is the RON 95 Gasoline Tank, with a storage capacity of 25,000 barrels. South-east of the gasoline tanks is the Pump Pad area which consists of booster pumps, pipeline pumps and the metering skid.
