MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(SIXTY-SECOND ANNIVERSARY OF INDEPENDENCE
CELEBRATIONS IN SCARBOROUGH, TOBAGO) ORDER, 2024

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Sixty-Second Anniversary of Independence Celebrations in Scarborough, Tobago) Order, 2024. Citation

2. This Order shall have effect between 6.00 p.m. on Friday 30th August, 2024 and 12.00 noon on Saturday 31st August, 2024. Duration

3. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not park his motor vehicle— Parking prohibited

(a) from 6.00 a.m. on Friday 30th August, 2024 to 12.00 noon on Saturday 31st August, 2024 at the following Car Parks:

- (i) N.I.B. Mall (Formerly FCB Car Park); and
- (ii) Market Square Car Park.

(b) from 7.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. on Saturday 31st August, 2024 on the following roads:

- (i) Wilson Road between Claude Noel Highway and Milford Road;
- (ii) Bacolet Street;
- (iii) Post Office Street;
- (iv) Garden Side Street between Darrel Spring Road and Carrington Street;
- (v) Carrington Street;
- (vi) Sangster's Hill; and
- (vii) Dutch Fort Connector Road.

Vehicular
traffic
prohibited

4. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not drive his motor vehicle during the passage of the parade on Saturday 31st August, 2024 from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.—

(a) on the following roads:

- (i) Claude Noel Highway between Bacolet Street and Wilson Road traffic lights;
- (ii) Friends Field Road between the Dwight Yorke Parade Grounds and Calder Hall Phase 1; and
- (iii) Milford Road between Dutch Fort Junction and Sangster's Hill Junction.

(b) to enter the Claude Noel Highway from the following roads:

- (i) Bagatelle Number 2;
- (ii) Calder Hall Road;
- (iii) Rockly Vale;
- (iv) Darrel Spring Road;
- (v) Wilson Road;
- (vi) Carrington Street; and
- (vii) Milford Road.

Alternative
route

5. From 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Saturday 31st August, 2024, the driver of a motor vehicle—

(a) entering Scarborough—

- (i) east of Bacolet Street along Claude Noel Highway, shall turn left onto Bacolet Street and continue west into Scarborough;
- (ii) west of Orange Hill Road along Claude Noel Highway, shall turn right onto Orange Hill Road to proceed to Scarborough;
- (iii) from the North Side Road, shall proceed south across the Claude Noel Highway onto upper Scarborough; and
- (iv) from Calder Hall, shall proceed south across the Claude Noel Highway to Scarborough.

(b) exiting Scarborough to proceed to—

- (i) the eastern side of Tobago, shall proceed east along Northside Road Connector *via* Crooks River, south along Burnette Street, north along Main Street, turning south onto Bacolet Street then east onto Claude Noel Highway;
- (ii) the western side of Tobago, shall proceed west along Carrington Street, onto Milford Road, North along Orange Hill Road to the Crusoe Bypass or west along the Claude Noel Highway;
- (iii) Calder Hall, shall proceed north across the Claude Noel Highway; and
- (iv) Plymouth Road, shall proceed north along Dutch Fort Connector Road or Sangster’s Hill, turn left onto Wilson Road and proceed north across the Claude Noel Highway.

6. A driver of a motor vehicle may park in the following areas:

Parking permitted

- (a) Republic Bank Car Park at Main Street;
- (b) Old Market Car Park at Piggott Street; and
- (c) the Car Park on the eastern side of Dwight Yorke Stadium.

7. Emergency vehicles at the parade’s dismissal point (Port Compound), shall proceed north along Custom Street, turn west onto Carrington Street, onto Milford Road, north onto Orange Hill Road, onto Claude Noel Highway to Scarborough Regional Hospital.

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
