ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(NATIONAL DAY OF REMEMBRANCE) ORDER, 2024

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (National Day of Remembrance) Order, 2024.

2. This Order has effect from 8.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on Sunday Duration 10th November, 2024.

3. A person is prohibited from parking a motor vehicle on—

Parking prohibited

- (a) Queen's Park East;
- (b) Jerningham Avenue, between Queen's Park East and Norfolk Street;
- (c) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane;
- (d) that part of the road to which the public are granted access to enter the Queen's Park Savannah, proceeding north from the corner of Frederick Street and Queen's Park West (commonly referred to as "the Drag");
- (e) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane;
- (f) Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Dundonald Street;
- (g) Frederick Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West;
- (h) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
- (i) Abercromby Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
- (j) New Street, between Pembroke Street and Charlotte Street;

- (k) Dundonald Street, between Queen's Park West and Albion Street;
- (l) Albion Street, between Chancery Lane and Dundonald Street; and
- (m) Chancery Lane.

Vehicular
traffic
prohibited

4. A person is prohibited from driving a motor vehicle from 9.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon on—

- (a) Queen's Park East, between Jerningham Avenue and Queen's Park West;
- (b) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Frederick Street;
- (c) Charlotte Street, between Queen's Park West and Gordon Street;
- (d) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Keate Street;
- (e) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street; and
- (f) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street.

Vehicular
traffic
diverted

5. A person driving a motor vehicle from 9.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon, shall proceed—

- (a) south on Queen's Park East and turn east onto Jerningham Avenue;
- (b) west on Jerningham Avenue, between Belmont Circular Road and Norfolk Street and turn north or south onto Norfolk Street;
- (c) south on Archer Street and turn east onto Jerningham Avenue;
- (d) north on Charlotte Street and turn west onto Gordon Street; and
- (e) north on Henry Street and turn east onto New Street or west onto Gordon Street.

One-way
traffic

6. A person driving a motor vehicle from 8.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon, shall proceed along Jerningham Avenue, between Queen's Park East and Norfolk Street, in an easterly direction only.

7. During the observance of the two minutes of silence from 11.00 a.m. to 11.02 a.m., police officers on duty shall bring to a standstill all vehicular traffic within the area bounded on the north by Queen's Park West, on the south by Gordon Street, on the east partly by Queen's Park East and partly by Charlotte Street and on the west by Chancery Lane. Two minutes of silence

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked Chap. 48:50
