ORDER

Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (CARNIVAL) ORDER, 2024

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Carnival) Order, 2024.
 - 2. In this Order— Interpretation

"Carnival Monday" means Monday 12th February, 2024; and

"Carnival Tuesday" means Tuesday 13th February, 2024.

3. This Order has effect from Friday 9th February, 2024 to Duration Carnival Tuesday, inclusive.

PART I

PORT-OF-SPAIN

Division 1—Vehicular Traffic and Parking

- 4. (1) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and Vehicular 10.00 p.m., vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on the following traffic and parking and on all roads lying within and bounded by them:
 - (a) Duke Street, between Belgrade Street and Wrightson Road;
 - (b) Park Street, between Stone Street and Piccadilly Street;
 - (c) Flament Street, between Stone Street and Wrightson Road;
 - (d) Independence Square North, between Wrightson Road and Piccadilly Street;
 - (e) Independence Square South, between Wrightson Road and Piccadilly Street;
 - (f) St. Joseph Road, between Piccadilly Street and Vieira Street;
 - (g) Charlotte Street;

- (h) Nelson Street;
- (i) Duncan Street;
- (j) Fraser Street;
- (k) Richmond Street;
- (1) St. Vincent Street;
- (m) Abercromby Street;
- (n) Frederick Street;
- (o) Henry Street;
- (p) Sackville Street;
- (q) Broadway;
- (r) Queen Janelle Commissiong Street;
- (s) South Quay, between Nelson Street and Wrightson Road;
- (t) New Street;
- (u) Belmont Circular Road, between Charlotte Street and the entrance to the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (v) Phillip Street;
- (w) Tragarete Road, between Damien Street and St. Vincent Street:
- (x) Piccadilly Street, between Park Street and South Quay;
- (y) Gray Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;
- (z) Alexandra Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;
- (aa) Elizabeth Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road; and
- (bb) St. Clair Avenue, between Elizabeth Street and Western Main Road.
- (2) Notwithstanding subclause (1)(s), the driver of a taxi plying the San Fernando, Chaguanas, Sangre Grande, Arima or Tunapuna to Port-of-Spain route may park in accordance with clauses 14 and 16.
- (3) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on the following roads lying within and bounded by the specified roads:
 - (a) Queen's Park West, from Queen's Park East to St. Clair Roundabout;
 - (b) Sweet Briar Road;

- (c) Gray Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road;
- (d) Alexandra Street, between Serpentine Road and Tragarete Road;

- (bb) Siparia Hill;
- (cc) Bath Street;

- (ff) Mary Street, between Serpentine Road and Hayes Street;
- (gg) Hayes Street, between Serpentine Road and Maraval Parkway;
- (hh) Flood Street, between Serpentine Road and Alexandra Street;
- (ii) Flood Street, between Mary Street and Maraval Road; and
- (jj) Pole Carew Street.

Parking prohibited

- 5. (1) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., parking is prohibited on the streets bounded by Wrightson Road on the south and Ariapita Avenue on the north as follows:
 - (a) Petra Street.
 - (b) Ana Street:
 - (c) Gallus Street;
 - (d) Alberto Street;
 - (e) Rosalino Street;
 - (f) Luis Street;
 - (g) Alfredo Street;
 - (h) Carlos Street;

- (2) Vehicular traffic shall proceed in both directions on the streets referred to in subclause (1).
- (3) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of $2.00\,$ a.m. and $10.00\,$ p.m., parking is prohibited on the following roads:
 - (a) Oxford Street, between Observatory Street and Dundonald Street; and
 - (b) Stone Street.
- (4) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., parking is prohibited on—
 - (a) Circular Road, between St. Clair Roundabout and Jerningham Avenue;
 - (b) Maraval Road, between Circular Road and Tragarete Road;

- (c) St. Clair Avenue;
- (d) Damian Street;
- (e) De Verteuil Street;
- (f) Dennis Mahabir Street;
- (g) Wrightson Road;

- (y) Archer Street;
- (z) Cadiz Road;
- (aa) Lady Young Road, between the entrance to Trinidad Hilton and St. Ann's Roundabout;
- (bb) Serpentine Road;
- (cc) Prada Street;
- (dd) Gaston Johnson Street;
- (ee) Panka Street;
- (ff) Lucknow Street;
- (gg) Belmont Circular Road, between Norfolk Street and Queen's Park East; and
- (hh) Norfolk Street.

- (5) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and midnight and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., parking is prohibited on—
 - (a) the portion of South Quay and the Eastern Main Road, between Vieira Street, Port-of-Spain and Bushe Street, San Juan; and
 - (b) Abattoir Road, between the Priority Bus Route and Beetham Highway.

One-way

- 6. (1) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., vehicular traffic shall proceed along Stone Street, between Wrightson Road and Park Street, in a southerly direction only.
- (2) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., vehicular traffic shall proceed along Prada Street, between Maraval Road and Wainwright Street, in a westerly direction only.

Two-way traffic

- 7. (1) On Carnival Monday and on Carnival Tuesday, vehicular traffic may proceed in both directions—
 - (a) around the Queen's Park Savannah, between Casual Corner and Jerningham Avenue;
 - (b) on Observatory Street, between Quarry Street and Belmont Circular Road;
 - (c) on Belmont Circular Road, between Observatory Street and the entrance to the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
 - (d) on Oxford Street, between Observatory Street and Charlotte Street;
 - (e) on Gaston Johnson Street;
 - (f) on Panka Street, between Gaston Johnson Street and Lucknow Street;
 - (g) on Lucknow Street; and
 - (h) on Rapsey Street, between Maraval Road and Wainwright Street.
- (2) On Carnival Tuesday, vehicular traffic may proceed in both a northerly and southerly direction on the northbound carriageway of Maraval Parkway, between Belle Smythe Street and Wrightson Road.

Route for vehicles proceeding to St. James from Belmont and St. Ann's

8. Vehicular traffic proceeding to St. James from Belmont or St. Ann's shall proceed west along Circular Road, north onto Maraval Road, west onto Rapsey Street and then onto Barbados Road.

9. Vehicular traffic proceeding to the Port-of-Spain General Route for Hospital on an emergency shall proceed along one of the following vehicles on an routes and shall leave the Port-of-Spain General Hospital along the Port-of-Spain reverse of the route:

Hospital

- (a) north along Henry Street, east onto New Street, onto Charlotte Street and then into the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (b) from Belmont Circular Road onto Observatory Street to the Port-of Spain General Hospital;
- (c) north along French Street onto Maraval Road, east onto Warner Street, south onto Cipriani Boulevard, east onto Melville Street, south onto Dundonald Street, east onto New Street, onto Charlotte Street and enter the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (d) north along Long Circular Road, south onto Maraval Road, east onto Warner Street, south onto Cipriani Boulevard, east onto Melville Street, south onto Dundonald Street, east onto New Street, onto Charlotte Street and enter the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (e) west along Lady Young Road, south onto Queen's Park East, then onto Charlotte Street and then into the Port-of-Spain General Hospital via the Maternity Ward Entrance; or
- (f) east along Sackville Street, north onto Edward Street, east onto New Street, onto Charlotte Street and then into the Port-of-Spain General Hospital.

Division 2—Taxi and Maxi-taxi Stands

- 10. This Division has effect from 2:00 a.m. on Carnival Monday Duration and on Carnival Tuesday.
- 11. The driver of a taxi assigned to the taxi stand on Chacon Long Circular/ Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall Wrightson Road operate from the northern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road taxi stand and the entrance to the Port Authority.
- 12. The driver of a taxi assigned to the taxi stand on South Quay, Diego Martin/ between Broadway and Abercromby Street and the taxi stand on Hart Petit Valley/ St. James Street shall operate from the southern side of Dock Road, between taxi stand Wrightson Road and the entrance to the Port Authority.
- 13. The driver of a taxi assigned to the taxi stand on the southern "On-call"/ side of Independence Square North, between Abercromby Street and St. Ice House taxi stand Vincent Street and on the eastern and western sides of Cipriani Circle, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South shall operate on Charles Street, from Scott Bushe Street, facing west.

San Fernando/ Chaguanas taxi stand

- 14. The driver of a taxi assigned to taxi stands on Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South shall—
 - (a) operate the San Fernando taxi stand, on the northern side of South Quay, between George Street and Nelson Street, facing east; and
 - (b) operate the Chaguanas taxi stand, on the southern side of South Quay, between George Street and Nelson Street, facing east.

Morvant/Trou Macaque taxi stand 15. The driver of a taxi assigned to the Morvant/Trou-Macaque taxi stand shall operate on the southern side of the east bound carriageway off the Old St. Joseph Road, east of Piccadilly Street, facing east.

Tunapuna/ Arima/ Sangre Grande taxi stand 16. The driver of a taxi assigned to the taxi stand on Henry Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay shall operate on the southern side of South Quay, between Nelson Street and Duncan Street.

San Juan/ Round-the-Road taxi stand 17. Taxi drivers assigned to San Juan/Round-the-Road routes shall operate from the northern side of South Quay, between Nelson Street and Duncan Street.

Belmont taxi stand 18. The driver of a taxi assigned to the taxi stand on Queen Street and Charlotte Street shall operate from Observatory Street and Charlotte Street.

Maraval taxi stand 19. The driver of a taxi assigned to the taxi stand on Duke Street and Charlotte Street shall operate from Belmont Circular Road and Belleau Road.

Carenage taxi stand 20. The driver of a taxi assigned to the taxi stand on Green Corner shall operate from Duke Street and Stone Street.

Hospital taxi stand 21. The driver of a taxi assigned to the taxi stand on South Quay and Charlotte Street shall operate from South Quay between George Street and Nelson Street.

St. Ann's taxi stand 22. The driver of a taxi assigned to the taxi stand on Hart Street shall operate from the northern side of Jerningham Avenue, in the vicinity of TSTT, facing east.

Route 1 maxi-taxis 23. The driver of a Route 1 maxi-taxi shall enter the maxi-taxi stand on South Quay by way of the Beetham Highway and exit via the southern side of South Quay, forty metres east of the Beetham Highway.

Division 3—Parade of Bands

24. (1) A band proceeding to the Queen's Park Savannah Bands Competition Centre shall proceed north along Charlotte Street, west entering and onto Queen's Park West and then north into the Queen's Park Queen's Park Savannah.

Savannah Competition Centre

- (2) A band exiting the Queen's Park Savannah shall proceed south along Victoria Avenue and then west onto Tragarete Road.
- 25. A band proceeding to the Adam Smith Square Competition Bands Centre shall proceed along Tragarete Road, south onto Pole Carew entering Adam Smith Street, onto Ana Street and then proceed east along Ariapita Avenue.

Competition

26. A band proceeding to the South Quay Competition Centre Bands shall proceed from Richmond Street, onto South Quay, then exit east entering and along South Quay, north along Charlotte Street or proceed east along South Quay Independence Square South, onto Piccadilly Street.

leaving from Competition

27. A band proceeding to the Soca Drome, at Hasley Crawford Bands Stadium, shall proceed along Damian Street, south onto Taylor Street, entering west onto Ariapita Avenue, south onto Maraval Parkway on the south bound carriageway only and then into the Hasley Crawford Stadium via Castro Gate.

28. (1) A band proceeding to the Piccadilly Street Competition Bands Centre shall proceed east along Independence Square South and then entering and leaving north onto Piccadilly Street.

Piccadilly Street

- (2) A band exiting the Piccadilly Street Competition Centre Competition shall proceed north along Piccadilly Street; west onto Park Street, north along Charlotte Street and then west onto Queen's Park West to enter the Queen's Park Savannah.
- 29. Vehicular traffic shall enter the Queen's Park Savannah at the Entry of following locations:

vehičles into the Queen's Park Savannah

- (a) Queen's Park East, near St. Ann's Roundabout; and
- (b) Queen's Park west at

 30. Vehicular traffic shall exit the Queen's Park Savannah at Exit of vehicles from the Queen's Park Savannah Queen's Park West at Casual Corner.

31. (1) A person attending the parade of bands at the DRAG may Parking of park his vehicle in the Queen's Park Savannah during the period vehicles in the Queen's Park commencing three hours prior to the start of the parade of bands and Savannah ending three hours after the closure of the parade of bands.

(2) Parking in the Queen's Park Savannah shall be in accordance with the directions of the police officer on duty.

Division 4—Traffic Light Signal

Operation of traffic light signal

32. Traffic light signals shall not be in operation from 2.00 a.m. on Carnival Monday to Carnival Tuesday.

PART II

St. James

Duration

- 33. This Part has effect on—
 - (a) Carnival Monday, from 4.00 a.m.; and
 - (b) Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 11.00 p.m.

Division 1—Vehicular Traffic and Parking

Closure of Western Main Road

- 34. (1) Western Main Road shall be closed to vehicular traffic from George Cabral Street to Long Circular Road. on Carnival Monday from 4.00 a.m. and on Carnival Tuesday between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 11.00 p.m.
- (2) During the periods referred to in subclause (1), vehicular traffic may utilise Mucurapo Road or Patna Street.

Parking prohibited

- 35. Parking is prohibited on—
 - (a) Western Main Road, between Damien Street and Mucurapo Link Road;
 - (b) Matura Street, between Western Main Road and Mucurapo Road;
 - (c) Mucurapo Road, between Mucurapo Link Road and Ana Street;
 - (d) Damien Street, between Western Main Road and Ariapita Avenue;
 - (e) Long Circular Road, between Western Main Road and Delhi Street;
 - (f) Delhi Street, between Long Circular Road and Kathleen Street;
 - (g) Kathleen Street, between Delhi Street and George Cabral Street;
 - (h) Salazar Street, between George Cabral Street and Church Street;
 - (i) Church Street, between Salazar Street and George Cabral Street;

- (j) George Cabral Street, between Western Main Road and Long Circular Road;
- (k) Bournes Road, between Western Main Road and Panta Street;
- (l) Taylor Street;
- (m) Belle Smythe Street;
- (n) Ariapita Avenue;
- (o) Salazar Street between Western Main Road and Church Street; and
- (p) Maraval Parkway.

Division 2—Emergency Provisions

- 36. In the event of an emergency, masqueraders and spectators $_{\rm individulas}^{\rm Foundation}$ shall be directed to evacuate the area via any of the following $_{\rm individulas}^{\rm routes}$ evacuation routes:
 - (a) north along Bournes Road to Kathleen Street, west along Kathleen Street to George Cabral Street to proceed either south or north along George Cabral Street;
 - (b) west along Western Main Road to George Cabral Street, and then continue to proceed either west along Western Main Road or north onto George Cabral Street;
 - (c) east along Western Main Road to Roxy Roundabout, and then continue to proceed east along Tragarete Road, south along Damien Street onto Mucurapo Road or east along St. Clair Avenue; or
 - (d) south along Ethel Street onto Mucurapo Road to proceed either east or west along Mucurapo Road.
- 37. (1) In the event of an emergency, vehicular traffic shall access Emergency the St. James Medical Facility by proceeding along Long Circular Road, route for between Western Main Road and Delhi Street, west onto Delhi Street, traffic continuing onto Kathleen Street and south onto Western Main Road.
- (2) Vehicular traffic exiting the St. James Medical Facility by proceeding along the reverse of the route set out in subclause (1).
- (3) Vehicular traffic may also proceed onto Audrey Jeffers Highway, onto Western Main Road, onto George Cabral Road, onto Kathleen Street, onto Barbados Road, onto Saddle Road and then to the Queen's Park Savannah.
- (4) Vehicular traffic may utilise Mucurapo Road and Patna Street, during the period of the road closures.

Muster points

- 38. The following locations are designated muster points:
 - (a) the Hasley Crawford Training Ground;
 - (b) the Hasley Crawford National Stadium; and
 - (c) the St. James Police Station.

Division 3—Taxi Stands

Taxi stands

- 39. (1) On Carnival Monday, from 4.00 a.m., and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 11.00 p.m., taxi stands shall operate as follows:
 - (a) Port-of-Spain taxis, on the corner of Long Circular Road and Barbados Road; and
 - (b) taxis heading west, on the corner of Coronation Street and Western Main Road.
- (2) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m., an individual can access a taxi on Mucurapo Road and Audrey Jeffers Highway.

Soca Drome

- 40. From Roxy Roundabout—
 - (a) west along Western Main Road, St James;
 - (b) south along Mathura Street;
 - (c) east along Mucurapo Street;
 - (d) south along Taylor Street;
 - (e) west along Ariapita Avenue;
 - (f) south along Maraval Parkway;
 - (g) around the Hasley Crawford Stadium into Jean Pierre Complex (The Soca Drome);
 - (h) exit Jean Pierre complex onto Fitzblackman Drive;
 - (i) north along O'Connor Street; and
 - (j) east onto Ariapita Avenue re-joining the parade route

PART III San Juan

Parking and vehicular traffic prohibited

- 41. (1) Parking is prohibited on First Avenue, between First Street and Eastern Main Road, and First Street, between First Avenue and Eastern Main Road on—
 - (a) Sunday 11th February, 2024, between the hours of 12.00 noon and 8.00 p.m.;
 - (b) Carnival Monday, between the hours of 6.00 p.m. and 9.00 p.m.; and
 - (c) Carnival Tuesday, from 10.00 a.m.

- $(2)\;$ On Carnival Monday and Carnival Tuesday, from 10.00 a.m., vehicular traffic is prohibited on—
 - (a) Eastern Main Road, between First Avenue and Aranguez Main Road, for vehicles proceeding east;
 - (b) Eastern Main Road, between Aranguez Main Road and Saddle Road, for vehicles proceeding west;
 - (c) Saddle Road, between Eastern Main Road and First Street;
 - (d) Second Street, between First Avenue and Saddle Road; and
 - (e) Coldatinda Avenue.
- $(3) \ \ {\rm On\ Carnival\ Monday\ and\ Carnival\ Tuesday,\ from\ 10.00\ a.m.,} \\ parking is\ prohibited\ on--$
 - (a) Eastern Main Road, between First Avenue and Aranguez Main Road;
 - (b) Eastern Main Road, between Aranguez Main Road and Saddle Road;
 - (c) Saddle Road, between Eastern Main Road and First Street;
 - (d) Second Street, between First Avenue and Saddle Road; and
 - (e) Coldatinda Avenue.
- 42. Vehicular traffic is prohibited along Saddle Road, between Vehicular Eastern Main Road and First Street on—
 - (a) Sunday 11th February, 2024, between the hours of 12.00 noon and 8.00 p.m.;
 - (b) Carnival Monday, between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m.;
 - (c) Carnival Monday, from 6.00 p.m.;
 - (d) Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m.; and
 - (e) Carnival Tuesday, from 4.00 p.m.

PART IV

TUNAPUNA

- 43. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on Eastern Main Road, between Vehicular El Dorado Road and Tunapuna Road on—
 - (a) Sunday 11th February, 2024, between the hours of 12.00 noon and 6.00 p.m.;

- (b) Carnival Monday between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m.;
- (c) Carnival Monday, from 3.00. p.m.; and
- (d) Carnival Tuesday, from 2.00 p.m.

No entry to vehicular traffic

- 44. (1) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on Sunday 11th February, 2024, between the hours of 12.00 noon and 6.00 p.m., Carnival Monday, between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. and from 3.00 p.m. from entering—
 - (a) Tunapuna Road, from Eastern Main Road;
 - (b) Green Street, from Tunapuna Road;
 - (c) Fairley Street, from Sheriff Street;
 - (d) Harrinauth Street, from Eastern Main Road; and
 - (e) El Dorado Road, between Lackpat Street and Eastern Main Road.
- (2) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on Carnival Monday, from 3.00 p.m. and on Carnival Tuesday, from 2.00 p.m. from entering—
 - (a) Tunapuna Road, from Eastern Main Road;
 - (b) Fairley Street, from Sheriff Street; and
 - (c) El Dorado Road, from Eastern Main Road.

Vehicular traffic routes

- 45. Vehicular traffic proceeding—
 - (a) east along Eastern Main Road, shall turn north along Tunapuna Road, east along Green Street, south along El Dorado Road, east along Lackpat Street, south along Harrinauth Street and then turn east to continue along Eastern Main Road; and
 - (b) west along Eastern Main Road, shall turn north onto El Dorado Road, west along Green Street, south along Fairley Street, west along Sheriff Street, south along Tunapuna Road and then turn west to continue along Eastern Main Road.

Parking prohibited
