## ORDER

Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

## THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (CORPUS CHRISTI) ORDER, 2024

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Corpus Christi) Order, 2024.
- 2. This Order shall have effect between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and Duration 2.00 p.m. on Thursday 30th May, 2024.
  - 3. A driver shall not park his motor vehicle on-

Parking prohibited

- (a) Park Street, between Frederick Street and Picadilly Street;
- (b) Henry Street, between Independence Square South and Park Street;
- (c) George Street, between South Quay and Independence Square North;
- (d) Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Nelson Street;
- (e) Independence Square South, between Henry Street and Duncan Street; and
- (f) Nelson Street, between Duke Street and South Quay.
- 4. A driver shall not drive his motor vehicle between the hours of Vehicular 9.30 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. on the following roads: traffic prohibited
  - (a) Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Nelson Street;
  - (b) Independence Square South, between Nelson Street and Henry Street;
  - (c) Henry Street, between Independence Square South and Park Street;
  - (d) Park Street, between Frederick Street and Picadilly Street;

- (e) Picadilly Street, between Park Street and Duke Street;
- (f) Duke Street, between Picadilly Street and Nelson Street;
- (g) Nelson Street, between Duke Street and Independence Square South; and
- (h) George Street, between South Quay and Independence Square North.

Taxi stand

5. The taxi stand on George Street shall operate from the southern side of South Quay facing west between Duncan Street and George Street.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked Chap. 48:50 6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
