CONSUMER PRICE INDEX—May, 2025 (Base: January, 2015 = 100)

THE following Memorandum on the Consumer Price Index (formerly referred to as The Index of Retail Prices) is published for general information.

GENERAL INDEX

The Rate of Inflation, which measures the percentage change in the All Items Index for the month of May, 2025 over May, 2024, was 1.4%. This rate is more than that observed for the period May, 2024 over the period May, 2023, which was 0.9%.

The All Items Index calculated from the prices collected for the month of May, 2025 was 125.3, representing an increase of 0.1 points or 0.1% above the All Items Index for April, 2025.

SECTION INDICES

FOOD AND NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

The Index for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased from 152.9 in April, 2025 to 153.4 in May, 2025, reflecting an increase of 0.3%. Contributing significantly to this increase was the general upward movement in the prices of fresh whole chickens, cucumber, pumpkin, table margarine, instant coffee, white flour, oranges, bodi, soya bean oil and full cream milk. However, the full impact of these price increases was offset by the general decrease in the prices of irish potatoes, fresh carite, melongene, onions, ochroes, plantains, fresh king fish, garlic, pimento and frozen whole chicken.

Price changes in this section for the month of May, 2025 accounted for a net overall increase of 0.1 point.

OTHER SECTIONS

A further review of the data for May, 2025 compared with April, 2025 reflected decreases in the Sub-indices for Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of -0.3%, Clothing and Footwear -0.1 and Health of -0.1%. All other sections remained unchanged.
