MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(STATE VISIT OF THE PRIME MINISTER OF THE
REPUBLIC OF INDIA) ORDER, 2025

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation
Provisions) (State Visit of the Prime Minister of the Republic of India)
Order, 2025.

2. This Order commences on Wednesday 2nd July, 2025 at Duration
10.00 p.m. and expires on Friday 4th July, 2025 at 10.00 p.m.

3. Parking is prohibited on—

(a) Dock Road;

(b) Post Office Road; and

(c) the western side of the northbound carriageway of
Wrightson Road, between South Quay and Dock Road.

4. (1) On Friday 4th July, 2025 from 4.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m., parking
is prohibited on—

prohibited

(a) St. Vincent Street, between Gordon Street and
Independence Square North;

(b) Sackville Street, between Wrightson Road and St. Vincent
Street;

(c) Abercromby Street, between Independence Square North
and Park Street;

(d) Knox Street, between Abercromby Street and Frederick
Street;

(e) Hart Street;

(f) Duke Street, between Frederick Street and Wrightson
Road;

(g) Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby
Street;

- (h) Cipriani Boulevard;
- (i) Chancery Lane;
- (j) Colville Street; and
- (k) Circular Road.

(2) Notwithstanding subclause (1), the driver of a motor vehicle being used by a Member of Parliament may park on Hart Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street.

Taxis

5. On Friday 4th July, 2025 from 4.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m., a taxi driver plying—

- (a) the St. Ann's route from Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street; and
- (b) the St. James route from Hart Street, shall operate from the northern side of Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Henry Street.

Removal of
vehicles

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, a member of the Police Service may, in accordance with section 108 of the Act, remove or cause to be removed a vehicle that is parked in contravention of this Order, or left on any road in such a manner that it is likely to cause an obstruction to persons lawfully using the road.
