## ORDER

Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

## THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (LAVENTILLE STEELBAND FESTIVAL CELEBRATIONS) ORDER, 2025

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Laventille Steelband Festival Celebrations) Order, 2025.
- 2. This Order shall have effect from 2.00 p.m. on Saturday Duration 2nd August, 2025 to 1.00 a.m. on Sunday 3rd August, 2025.
- 3. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not park his motor vehicle on Parking the following roads:
  - (a) Eastern Main Road, between Morvant Junction and Old St. Joseph Road;
  - (b) Leotaud Street; and
  - (c) Old St. Joseph Road.
- 4. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not drive his motor vehicle on the Vehicular Eastern Main Road between Morvant Junction and Old St. Joseph Road. prohibited prohibited
- 5. A driver of a motor vehicle may proceed in both directions along Two-way the Old St. Joseph Road between Readymix Street and Leotaud Street. traffic
  - 6. A driver of a motor vehicle proceeding—

Traffic routes

- (a) west along the Eastern Main Road, upon reaching Morvant Junction, shall turn south onto the Beetham Highway Extension, west onto the Priority Bus Route and exit south onto Abattoir Road; and
- (b) east along the Eastern Main Road, shall divert onto Old St. Joseph Road and re-enter the Eastern Main Road via Leotaud Street and proceed east.

Priority bus

7. Notwithstanding the Classification of Highways Order, a driver route G.N. No. 51 of a motor vehicle may proceed west along the westbound carriageway of the Priority Bus Route between the junction of the Uriah Butler Highway and Priority Bus Route and Abattoir Road only.

Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked

8. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, a motor vehicle found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed, impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 108 and 109 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
