ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(ARIMA BOROUGH DAY PARADE) ORDER, 2025

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Arima Borough Day Parade) Order, 2025.
2. This Order shall have effect from 4.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight on Duration Saturday 9th August, 2025.
3. Drivers of motor vehicles shall not park or proceed on—

Vehicular
traffic and

prohibited

 - (a) Hollis Avenue, between Queen Mary Avenue and Lord Kitchener Avenue;
 - (b) Lord Kitchener Avenue, between Devenish Street and Robinson Circular;
 - (c) Robinson Circular, between Lord Kitchener Avenue and Railway Road;
 - (d) Queen Mary Avenue, between Railway Road and Hollis Avenue;
 - (e) King Street, between Hollis Avenue and Lopez Street;
 - (f) St. Joseph Street, between Hollis Avenue and Farfan Street;
 - (g) Lord Kitchener Avenue, between Farfan Street and Devenish Street;
 - (h) Loubon Street, between Quesnel Street and Lord Kitchener Avenue;
 - (i) Quesnel Street, between Lord Kitchener Avenue and Nelson Street; and
 - (j) Railway Road, between Providence Circular and Queen Mary Avenue.
4. Drivers of motor vehicles shall proceed along De Verteuil Street One-way traffic between Lord Kitchener Avenue and De Graft Street in an easterly direction only.

5. (1) On Saturday 9th August from 2.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m., the parade of the bands shall proceed east along Hollis Avenue, south along Lord Kitchener Avenue, west along Robinson Circular and north along Queen Mary Avenue.

(2) The staging area for the parade of the bands shall be located at Arima Bus Layby on Hollis Avenue.

6. (1) Drivers of taxis shall operate as follows:

- (a) Arima Old Road taxis shall operate from the eastern side of King Street facing south;
- (b) O'Meara Road taxis shall operate from the northern side of Farfan Street facing west; and
- (c) Malabar and Carapo taxis shall operate from Lord Kitchener Avenue in the vicinity of Malabar Road on the northern side facing west.

(2) The Bus Terminal on Hollis Avenue shall be relocated to operate from the Arima Licensing compound at the corner of the Priority Bus Route and Lisa Morris-Julien Boulevard.

7. Maxi-taxi drivers operating along the Priority Bus Route heading east shall turn north onto Olton Road from the Priority Bus Route.

8. (1) Drivers of emergency vehicles shall proceed west along Broadway Street onto the Arima Old Road, south onto Beckles Lane, east onto the Eastern Main Road and south onto Prince Bartholomew Drive to the Arima Health Facility.

(2) The muster points shall be located at Rose Park and Arima Velodrome.

9. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, a motor vehicle found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed, impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 108 and 109 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
