Ch. 12 No.4

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2026

Explanatory Note

(These notes form no part of the Bill but are intended only to indicate its general purport)

The Bill seeks to amend section 156(2) of the Public Health Ordinance Ch. 12 No. 4, to provide that all registration done under section 156(1) shall, unless cancelled, continue to be in force for a period of twelve months from the date of issue.

This Bill contains two clauses.

Clause 1 of the Bill would provide the short title of the Bill.

Clause 2 would provide for the amendment of section 156(2) of the Public Health Ordinance, by deleting the words “from the date of its issue until 31st December next thereafter” and substituting the words “for a period of twelve months from the date of issue of the relevant badge”.
