THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE  
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS  
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to LLOYD ODELL OSARATIN SEALEY of No. 3 Alice Street, Curepe and of No. 20 Susconusco No. 2, La Pastora Road, Santa Cruz, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said LLOYD ODELL OSARATIN SEALEY of No. 3 Alice Street, Curepe and of No. 20 Susconusco No. 2, La Pastora Road,

Santa Cruz, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre, located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said LLOYD ODELL OSARATIN SEALEY of No. 3 Alice Street, Curepe and of No. 20 Susconusco No. 2, La Pastora Road, Santa Cruz, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, LLOYD ODELL OSARATIN SEALEY is identified by confidential intelligence as the owner and principal person in control of “The Mansion Night Club,” which functions as the operational base for an organised criminal group/gang involved in human trafficking and the commercial sexual exploitation of foreign nationals. This organised criminal group falls within the Anti-Gang Act, 2021. On 15th March, 2026, law enforcement discovered forty-seven (47) female foreign migrants on the premises, alongside narcotics (marijuana and cocaine) and items consistent with a brothel operation. Intelligence indicates the detainee oversees a structured network that engages in violent criminal acts and recruits, harbours, and redistributes victims while laundering illicit proceeds. His detention is necessary to prevent the continuation of this organised criminal enterprise and to mitigate a significant threat to public safety.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
