THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE  
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS  
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to KENTON ANTHONY BIBBY also known as “GUNNA” of Light Pole No. 63A Upper Factory Road, Diego Martin, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said KENTON ANTHONY BIBBY also known as “GUNNA” of Light Pole No. 63A Upper Factory Road, Diego Martin, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre

located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said KENTON ANTHONY BIBBY also known as “GUNNA” of Light Pole No. 63A Upper Factory Road, Diego Martin, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody..

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee KENTON ANTHONY BIBBY also known as “GUNNA” has been credibly identified as a member of an Organised Crime Group (‘OCG’) within the legal definition of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021, which operates within the Diego Martin area and environs. The OCG has confirmed access to a cache of firearms and ammunition. The detainee plays a central role in the planning and coordination of violent operations of the OCG through the supply of illegal firearms and ammunition to gang members to facilitate homicides and other serious offences. He also is involved in illicit drug trafficking operations, with proceeds from these activities being used to finance the procurement of weaponry and to strengthen the gang’s influence within the community. He and others intend to imminently carry out acts of intimidation and retaliatory violence against rival gang members and witnesses in public spaces using firearms.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
