THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to JAMAL PIERRE of Building 39–41, Apartment C, Nelson Street, Port-of-Spain, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said JAMAL PIERRE of Building 39–41, Apartment C, Nelson Street, Port-of-Spain, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the

place where the said JAMAL PIERRE of Building 39–41, Apartment C, Nelson Street, Port-of-Spain, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, JAMAL PIERRE has been identified as an operational member of the “7 gang” based in Nelson Street, Port-of-Spain, which is an Organised Crime Group (‘OCG’) within the definition of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021. The OCG has access to a cache of firearms and ammunition. The detainee and others are engaged in a series of violent street crimes, including larceny from persons and robberies, to foster fear and maintain gang dominance in the Port-of-Spain commercial districts at the behest of senior gang members. Despite being on bail with curfew and reporting conditions he continues to engage in illicit criminal activities. Confidential information reveals that he presently has a leading role in sustaining gang operations and executing directives for the gang’s leadership.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
