THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to SHERWYN MARLON GUEVARRO also known as “MARLON” of No. 25 Fraser Street, Rio Claro and also of No. 30 Remy Trace, Penal Rock Road, Moruga, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said SHERWYN MARLON GUEVARRO also known as “MARLON” of No. 25 Fraser Street, Rio Claro and also of No. 30 Remy Trace, Penal Rock Road, Moruga, shall be detained at the

Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said SHERWYN MARLON GUEVARRO also known as “MARLON” of No. 25 Fraser Street, Rio Claro and also of No. 30 Remy Trace, Penal Rock Road, Moruga, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, SHERWYN MARLON GUEVARRO also known as “MARLON” has been credibly identified as a high-risk operational lead in an Organised Crime Group (‘OCG’) that is actively engaged in transnational human trafficking network based in Rio Claro. Following the detention of the network’s former leader, the detainee assumed operational control, serving as a facilitator, enforcer and sexual assessor for trafficked Venezuelan minors and adults. Confidential intelligence and information confirm the detainee’s central involvement in a coordinated pattern of conduct prejudicial to public safety, including kidnapping, the harbouring of victims, confiscation of mobile devices and the use of physical violence such as burning and branding victims with tattoos to denote ownership.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
